The Google.org Impact **Challenge for Women and Girls** commits \$25 million to fund organizations creating pathways to prosperity for women and girls. This is an open call for applications, and selected charitable initiatives will receive up to \$2 million, as well as opportunities for mentorship and additional support from Google.

THE PATH FORWARD 7,800 bold ideas that offer economic opportunities for women and girls

In light of the gender inequities exacerbated by Covid-19; the Google org Impact Challenge for Women and Girfs asked organizations around the world to submit their ideas to advance women's economic empowerment. The Google arg Impact Challenge, which will award 325 million in grants and technical support from Google, yielded thousands of applications. affirming the growing oplical momentum for gender equity. The social and economic toll of the pandemic will be levied disproportionately on women and girls. As world leaders look to build resiliency, women and girls need to be reflected in post-pandemic responses.



Greater investment in women and girls can not only lead to economic empowerment, but also help address broader facets of gender equality — an objective of the United Nations' 17 Sustainable Development Goals. Our data shows there are four main areas of focus for applicants:

SWATALEEM and HUMANE WARRIORS empower historically underrepresented 10- to 16-year-old girls in India by disseminating education through interactive voice response system technology.


Using audio files that can be played through speaker phones (no internet needed), girls will gain access to skills in math, science and financial awareness, including topics such as opening a bank account. The app will bring together parents, teachers, students and the government to create an ecosystem that supports the girls' education.



ASOCIACIÓN COLNODO connects rural women entrepreneurs to the internet and each other through cohort programming and mentorship. The association will bring internet access to 1,200 women and their families through eight community networks in disconnected rural areas, providing an environment for women to learn skills such as digital marketing, social commerce, financial education, ecommerce and content creation to boost their enterprises and improve their living conditions.



GIRLS INC. OF NEW YORK CITY inspires all girls to be strong, smart and bold, delivering lifetransforming programs so that girls and women can thrive and live equitable and productive lives. Through a financial budgeting app with customizable multicultural avatars, animated curriculum and a playful "bot" that nudges girls towards goals, the "Her Future Project" will teach financial literacy and planning.







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
